English Section 56

Becoming rooted and grounded in His love is essential for a godly life. First, we must understand the breadth, length, depth, and height of the love of Christ--- Ephesians 3:17-19. That secures advancement into maturity in our relationship with God. Knowing God's love is not enough. Many know of God's love for us, but continue to govern their lives with their love for Him. The Lord wants us to depend solely on His love for us. God is the spirit of love and will never fail, fall short, or need new supplies to keep going. Our passion for Him can die or fall short. Being securely rooted and grounded in His love for us does not allow us to fail in our walk with Him. If we fall short through sin, we know we can always run to Him, because He is love and will receive us. Being rooted in His love, we are a branch connected to a vine and draw our very life from that connection and bear fruit.

John 15:1-6

I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

2 Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

6 If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.

Abiding in His love is what makes us fruitful. That does not mean we can do more and better works for Him, although that might happen. It means that the fruits of our spirit flourish. That is a requirement, and we must abide in His love to live fruitful lives.

Our first love is that He loved us, so do not be like the Ekklesia at Ephesus and forget your first love. It does not take much effort to become confident in our love for Him and depend on that love to keep us. That is just another form of pride and will lead only to disappointment. However, as we grow, we

increasingly love Him and learn to live from and lean on His love for us. Having a child's desire to please such a loving parent constrains our behavior and compels us to conduct ourselves wisely and keep the law. However, his love for us and his working with us cause us to fulfill God's requirements.

English Section 57

As we grow in our confidence in His love for us, our faith in Him grows. Because of who He is, we know we can depend on Him in all things. Of course, He has always been faithful. Still, we must learn this for ourselves. Without faith, it is impossible to please Him. All things relating to life and godliness come to us through faith. Our faith receives the love of God and walks in it. He has loved from the beginning (before all things) and will still be love until the end because He is love. We must believe this, receive it, and learn to practice its reality until we reach the full maturity of our relationship with Him. That walk must become a part of our everyday life until it becomes who we are in Him. Let God's love for us renew our minds and transform us.

Spanish Section 56

Estar arraigados y cimentados en Su amor es esencial para una vida piadosa. En primer lugar, debemos comprender la anchura, la longitud, la profundidad y la altura del amor de Cristo (Efesios 3:17-19). Esto garantiza nuestro avance hacia la madurez en la relación con Dios. Al estar arraigados en Su amor, somos como una rama unida a la vid: extraemos nuestra propia vida de esa conexión y damos fruto.

1 YO soy la vid verdadera, y mi Padre es el labrador.

2 Todo pámpano que en mí no lleva fruto, le quitará: y todo aquel que lleva fruto, le limpiará, para que lleve más fruto.

3 Ya vosotros sois limpios por la palabra que os he hablado.

Permanecer en su amor es lo que nos hace fructíferos. Esto no significa que podamos realizar más obras —o mejores— para Él, aunque eso podría suceder; significa que los frutos de nuestro espíritu florecen. Es un requisito: debemos permanecer en su amor para vivir vidas fructíferas.

Nuestro primer amor es el hecho de que Él nos amó; por tanto, no imites a la Ekklesia de Éfeso olvidando tu primer amor. No hace falta mucho esfuerzo para confiar excesivamente en nuestro propio amor hacia Él y depender de ese amor para sostenernos; eso no es más que otra forma de orgullo que solo conducirá

a la decepción. Sin embargo, a medida que crecemos, le amamos más y aprendemos a vivir apoyándonos en su amor por nosotros. El deseo, propio de un niño, de agradar a un Padre tan amoroso guía nuestro comportamiento y nos impulsa a actuar con sabiduría y a guardar la ley; no obstante, es su amor por nosotros y su obra en nosotros lo que nos permite cumplir con los requisitos de Dios.
