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Ch 19 Servants vs. Sons

English Section 62

In Luke 15:11-32, the Lord tells the parable of a prodigal son. The son asked for his inheritance and went his way into the world. Unfortunately, he wasted his money on his rebellious lifestyle. Finally, after almost starving, he realized he would have a much better life if he returned to his father and asked for a job. Arriving at his father's house, he confessed that he was no longer qualified to be called his son but wanted only employment.

The father, however, was looking for his son, not a servant, and rejoiced at his son's return. He then reinstated the young man into his family, covering him with the robe which showed his right standing with the father, and giving him a signet ring, which was a sign to all that the son could do business as the father. He also gave his son sandals for his feet to show the world that his walk had changed. He was now walking with his father in total restoration.

Adam did not lose his position as God's son, only his right standing with God and his authority. Because Adam did not lose his relationship with God, we now know that all generations born of Adam are sons of God, though prodigal sons.

From the beginning, it has been the heart of God to have a kingdom ruled by his family of sons. When Christ came, He restored the righteousness and authority to rule His people. Many, however, refuse to accept His offer of sonship. Some will not accept Jesus at all and live their lives isolated from Him. It is as though He had never died. Others neglect God's offer of sonship and want only to serve as His servants, doing His will. They are missing out on the best God has paid for and given them. They could have so much more.

The Apostle, Prophet, Pastor, Evangelist, and Teacher are acceptable positions of servants in the Kingdom of God.

Ephesians 4:11-12

(11) And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

(12) For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

The Prophet/servant has authority over the house but does not live in the house. When evening comes, he departs to His own quarters to do his own thing. But the son lives in and rules the house forever. He lives, moves, and has His being in God; his identity has been transformed.

God knows that all people are His sons, welcome in His house to rule in righteousness. So why do we not understand this and accept His invitation to join Him? Why do we not agree with Him in His desire to have a kingdom ruled by His sons, not servants?

The child of a king differs in no way from a servant and must receive training and tutoring to rule and reign as king. The Holy Spirit teaches and coaches the child to live in the same home with the King of Kings; therefore, he partners with and constantly communicates with the Holy Spirit.

Spanish Section 62

En Lucas 15:11-32, el Señor relata la parábola del hijo pródigo. El hijo pidió su herencia y se marchó al mundo. Lamentablemente, malgastó su dinero en un estilo de vida rebelde. Finalmente, tras estar a punto de morir de hambre, comprendió que tendría una vida mucho mejor si regresaba con su padre y le pedía trabajo. Al llegar a casa de su padre, confesó que ya no era digno de ser llamado su hijo, sino que solo deseaba un empleo.

El padre, sin embargo, buscaba a su hijo, no a un siervo, y se regocijó por su regreso. Entonces restituyó al joven en la familia, cubriéndolo con el manto que simbolizaba su justa posición ante el padre y entregándole un anillo con sello, señal para todos de que el hijo podía realizar negocios en nombre del padre. También le dio sandalias para sus pies, demostrando al mundo que su caminar había cambiado; ahora caminaba junto a su padre en total restauración.

Adán no perdió su condición de hijo de Dios, sino únicamente su justa posición ante Dios y su autoridad. Dado que Adán no perdió su relación con Dios, sabemos ahora que todas las generaciones nacidas de Adán son hijos de Dios, aunque hijos pródigos.

Desde el principio, el deseo del corazón de Dios ha sido tener un reino gobernado por su familia de hijos. Cuando Cristo vino, restauró la justicia y la autoridad para gobernar a Su pueblo. Muchos, no obstante, se niegan a aceptar Su oferta de filiación. Algunos no aceptan a Jesús en absoluto y viven aislados de Él; es como si Él nunca hubiera muerto. Otros pasan por alto la oferta divina de filiación y solo desean servirle como siervos, cumpliendo Su voluntad. Se están perdiendo lo mejor que Dios ha pagado y les ha otorgado; podrían tener mucho más.

El apóstol, el profeta, el pastor, el evangelista y el maestro son posiciones aceptables de servicio en el Reino de Dios.

El profeta o siervo tiene autoridad sobre la casa, pero no habita en ella. Al llegar la tarde, se retira a sus propios aposentos para ocuparse de sus asuntos. En cambio, el hijo vive en la casa y gobierna sobre ella para siempre. Él vive, se mueve y tiene su ser en Dios; su identidad ha sido transformada.

Dios sabe que todas las personas son sus hijos y que son bienvenidas en su casa para gobernar con justicia. Entonces, ¿por qué no comprendemos esto ni aceptamos su invitación a unirnos a Él? ¿Por qué no compartimos su deseo de tener un reino gobernado por sus hijos, y no por siervos?

El hijo de un rey no se diferencia en nada de un siervo y debe recibir formación y tutoría para gobernar y reinar como rey. El Espíritu Santo enseña y capacita al hijo para convivir con el Rey de Reyes; por ello, el hijo colabora con el Espíritu Santo y mantiene una comunicación constante con Él.
